

Plato's *Symposium* Helpful Notes

181d3ff.

ώς + future participle (see Smyth 2086)

χρῆν (imperfect without augment); imperfect χρῆν without ἄν, introducing a present contrafactual

ἀνηλίσκετο from ἀναλίσκω

οῖ to what place, whither (+ gen.)

τελευτᾶ from τελευτάω

πέρι note the accent!

ἐκόντες from ἐκών, ἐκοῦσα, ἐκόν

τοὺς...ἔραστὰς acc. object of προσαναγκάζειν

πεποιηκότες perfect active participle, masculine nominative singular, of ποιέω

ἄστε + infinitive: what kind of clause?

ώς introducing indirect speech after λέγειν

αἰσχρόν [ἐστι]

τούτους (182a1) = common lovers

ἄν ... φέροι potential optative (Smyth 1824ff.)
