

## Plato's *Symposium* Helpful Notes

182a7ff.

ὥρισται 3rd person singular perfect passive indicative of ὀρίζω, ὀρίω, ὥρισα, ὥρικα, ὥρισμαι, ὥρίσθην “divide, bound, mark out by boundaries, limit”

οὗ “where”

νενομοθέτηται 3rd person singular perfect passive indicative of νομοθετέω

What is the antecedent of ὃ?

φιλεῖ can be used personally or impersonally to mean “be wont”; here its subject is ὁ Ἔρως

ἔτέθη 3rd person singular aorist passive indicative of τίθημι
